FOIA submission instructions:

Freedom of Information Act information requests can be made to the FOIA Officer: in person; over the phone; by email; by fax; or by regular mail.

The Library will, promptly, either comply with or deny a request for public records within 5 business days after its receipt of the request, unless the time for response is properly extended under subsection (e) of (5 ILCS 140/3) of the Illinois Freedom of Information Act. The first 50 pages of black and white, letter or legal paper are free. The fee for records copied, after the first 50 pages, will be \$.15 per page. Colored copies, copies sized other than legal or letter size, electronic records. e.g. disks, diskettes, tapes, etc., will be charged at the actual cost of reproduction. The fee for certification will be \$1.00 per certificate. Fees exceeding \$5.00 will be payable in advance.

Any denial for information may be appealed by the requestor to the Public Access Counselor (PAC) within 60 days after denial to:
